
Data Collection on Secondary Screenings

(Transportation Security Administration – Aviation Security)

“The Committee directs TSA to conduct comprehensive data collection as it relates to secondary screenings of individuals. This data will indicate the race, national origin, and religion of the travelers selected to undergo secondary screenings. TSA will audit its screening practices to guard against racial and religious profiling and will release such data to the public at the end of each year.”
